Ontario District 6 of the United Steelworkers of America is proud to put forward the name of Carrol Anne Sceviour as a candidate for our representative on the Ontario Federation of Labour Executive Board.

Carrol Anne Sceviour is the President of Steelworkers' Local 6624 at Central Precision Ltd., in Toronto. She has been a member of the local for 11 years and has been a steward, financial secretary, vice-president, chairperson of the safety and health and negotiating committees.

In her first term as president, Carrol Anne Sceviour led her local in a five-month strike against a vicious anti-union company. The notorious strikebreaking firm of Securicor policed the picket line and Carrol Anne Sceviour was arrested twice and barred from the picket line. She continued to lead the strike, heading up delegations seeking a fair settlement of her strike including up to the Minister of Labour. All 19 company concession demands were finally defeated and Securicor was fired by the employer because of the union campaign.

Carrol Anne Sceviour is chairperson of the Steelworkers' Toronto Area Council women's committee, head of the District 6 (Ontario region) women's committee and the representative of our union district on the OFL women's committee. As our representative Carrol Anne Sceviour has been an active lobbyist for day

care reform, a public speaker for the pro-choice campaign and political action for the NDP, a writer on sexual harassment and equal rights. She prepared and delivered our brief to the OFL's affirmative action forum in Toronto. She is an instructor in our union's education program and was a speaker on our panel at our district conference on the Future of the Union Movement.

Carrol Anne Sceviour is an active Steelworker and a dedicated trade unionist. She is a responsible and experienced union leader. We are confident that she will be an excellent representative for our union and will make an important contribution to the OFL executive team.

She has the support of the overwhelming majority of the OFL Executive Board including President Cliff Pilkey; Secretary-Treasurer Terry Meagher; Bob Nickerson, UAW; and Sean O'Flynn, OPSEU.

Carrol Anne Sceviour is running as part of a new leadership team for the five affirmative action positions.
